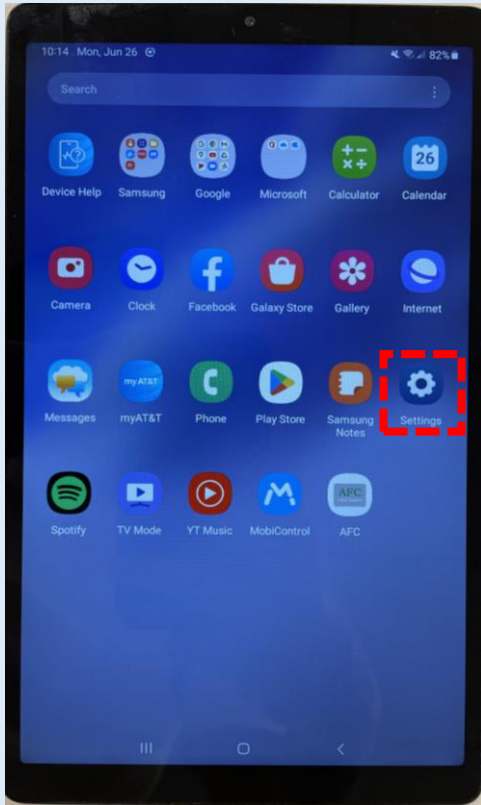


How to Pair (New tablet with ZD410)

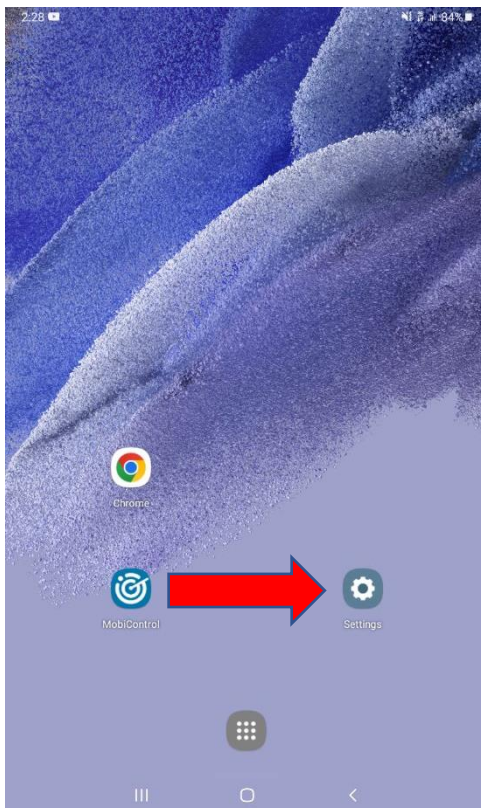
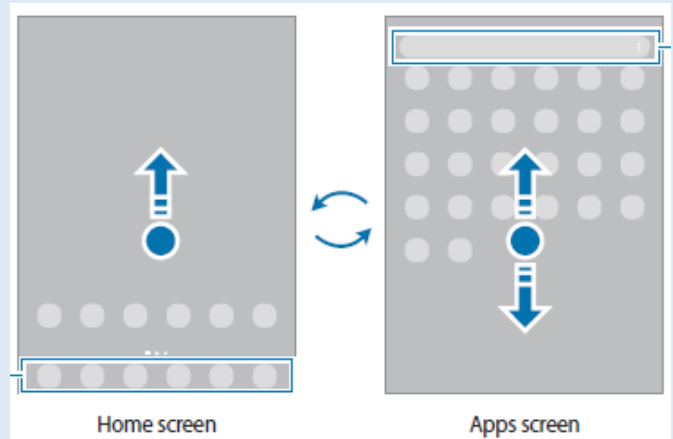

move to home screen.

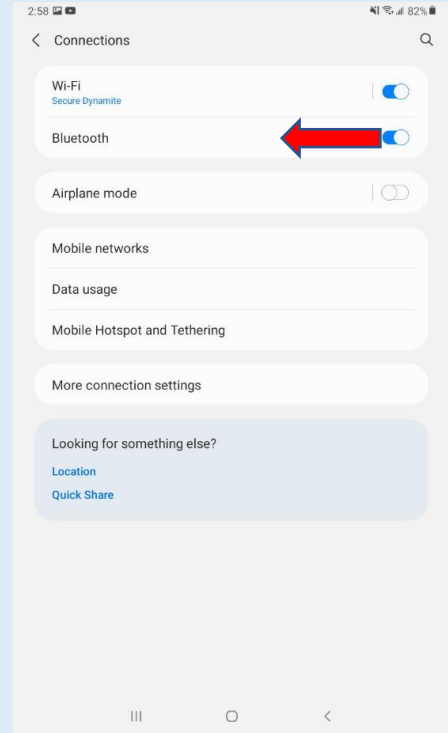
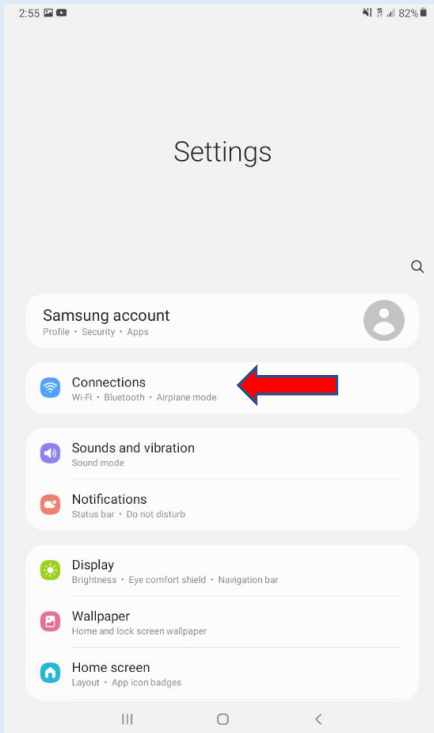


Go to Setting on the tablet.

on the tablet screen and you will be in
Apps screen.

Click the Setting and open it.

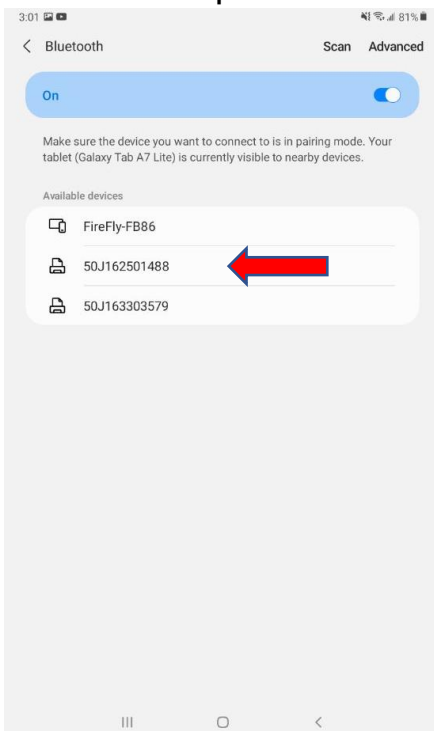
2 Click on **Connection** > Click on **Bluetooth** (make sure Bluetooth is on)

3 For Zebra **ZD410 printer**, you have to find the printer on the available devices list. Printer name/serial number usually starts with 50J or 50N. Click on the printer serial number.

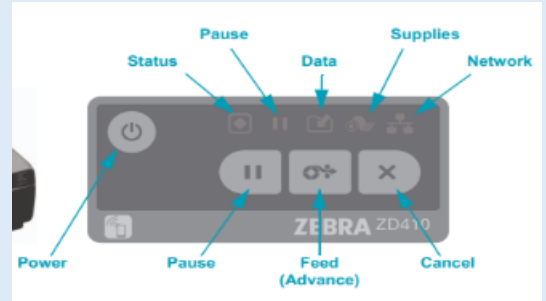
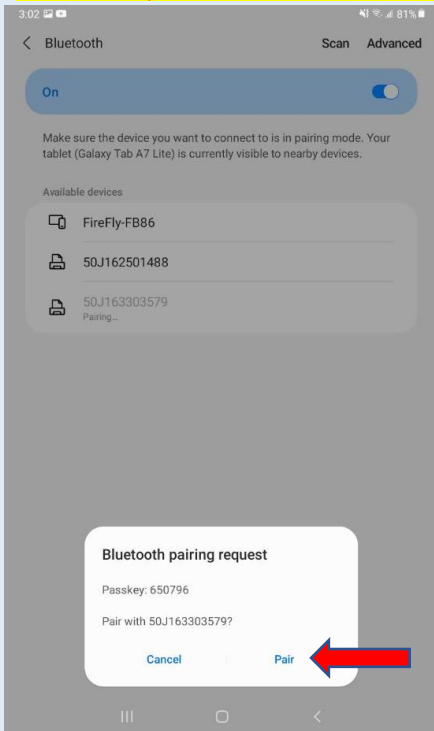

Bluetooth pairing request with passkey will pop up on the tablet. Printer will print out the passkey as well. Click on Pair. **If the printer serial number is not showing in available list or printer is not accepting pairing, press and hold feed button on the printer for about 6-7 seconds > you will see data light blinking (green arrow light) > now printer will show up on the list and available to pair.**

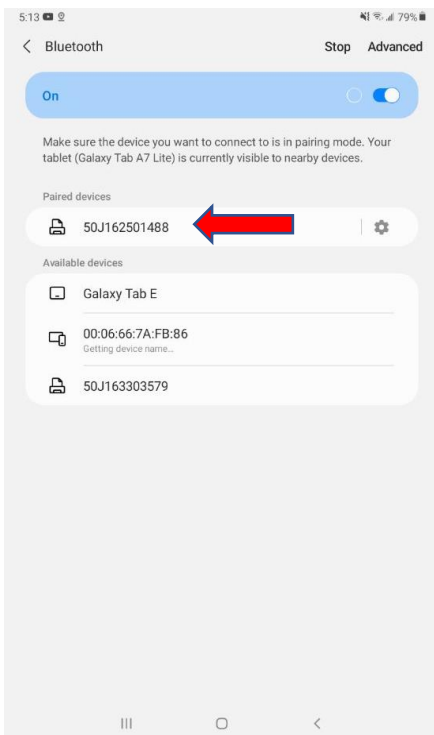

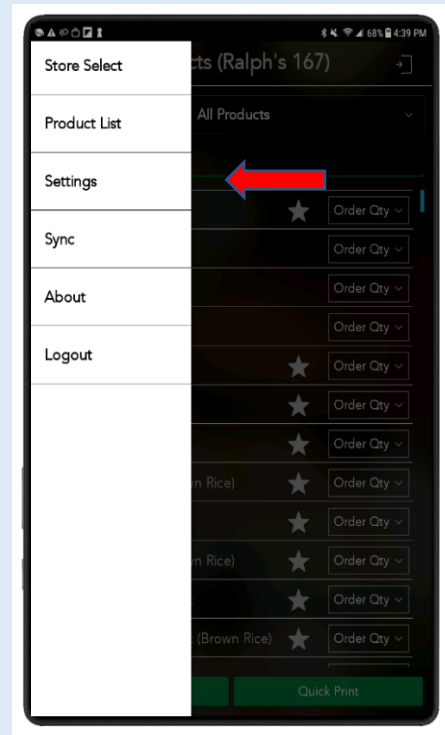
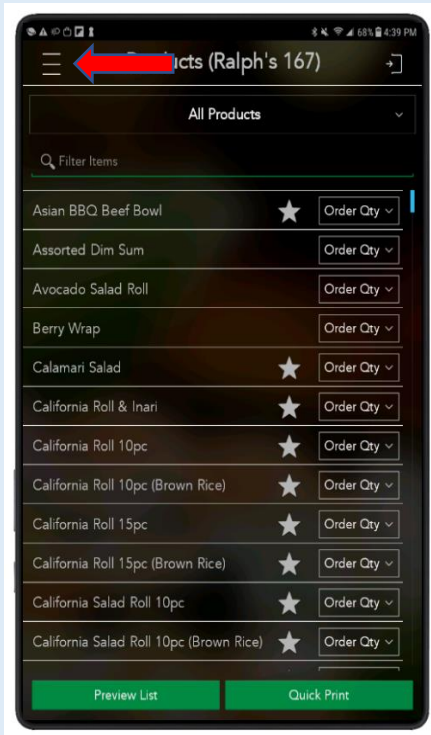
Once Bluetooth is paired with the tablet, you can see it under the Paired Device list. Now you can open the AFC Label application.

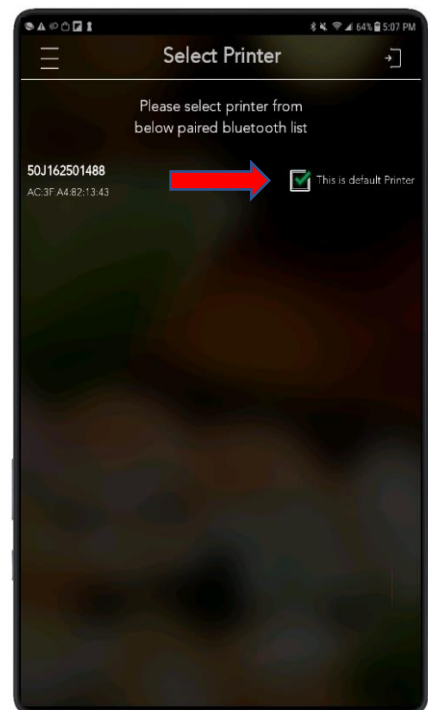
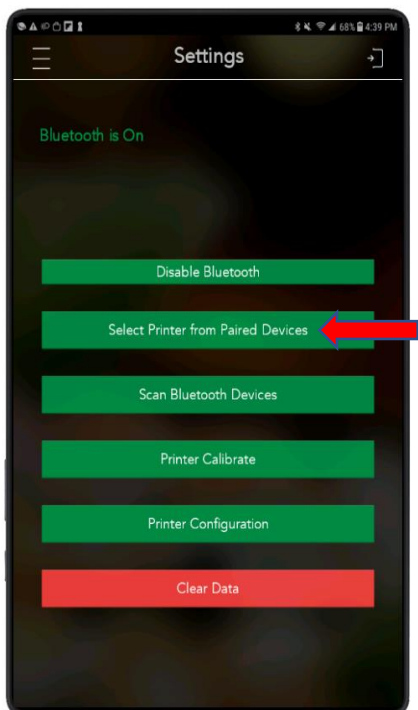
6 Click on the icon on the top left corner of the screen > Click on Setting
